Important notice for the applicants seeking admission into 2 year B.Ed./B.H.Ed./M.Ed. Courses at the State Public Universities and Colleges participating under SAMS for the Academic Session 2026-27

It is for information of all concerned that admission into 2 year B.Ed./B.H.Ed./M.Ed. Courses for the HEIs participating under SAMS shall be done through an Entrance test. Accordingly, the candidates are hereby instructed to fill-up the Common Application Form by visiting the SAMS B.Ed./B.H.Ed./M.Ed. portal as per the timeline mentioned below. Information Brochure for course B.Ed./B.H.Ed./M.Ed. is available on the SAMS portal. Please refer to the Information Brochure before filling up the CAF. The key points of e-Admission for the Academic Year 2026-27 are as follows.

1. Like the previous academic session, admissions into 2 year B.Ed./B.H.Ed./M.Ed. courses for the Academic Session 2026-27 shall be made exclusively on the basis of scores obtained in the Entrance Test.
2. In the current academic session, Phase-I admission will be conducted initially. Based on the availability of vacant seats, the Higher Education Department may consider conducting Phase-II or SPOT admissions later only for left out students.
3. Like previous Year, in the current academic session (AY: 2026-27), same counselling based online admission will be implemented. For Applicants who got a seat in a round are advised to choose one of the following options Freeze and Slide.
Freeze: - If an applicant is satisfied with the allotted HEI, S/he can choose this option. After selecting the "Freeze" option, applicants have to pay the admission fees for that seat allocated. The required fees will be shown in the screen and s/he has to pay the fees in online mode only. The applicants who will choose the "Freeze" option can download the Intimation Letter and have to visit the selected HEIs to complete the admission formalities.
Slide: - If an applicant has accepted the allotted seat but also wants for his/her higher preferences, s/he can choose this option. After selecting the "Slide" option, applicants have to pay the admission fees for that seat allocated. The required fees will be shown in the screen and s/he has to pay the fees in online mode only. However, such applicants need not have to visit the allocated HEIs, as they will not get the Intimation Letter and they will wait for the subsequent round of selection.
4. Whenever a seat is allocated, applicants are compulsorily required to choose one of the option - Freeze, or Slide - carefully. If the applicant will not choose any of the options that implies the applicant is rejecting the offered/allocated seat and s/he will be out of the counselling process for the subsequent rounds of that Phase. The detail process of "Freeze" & "Slide" is mentioned in the Information Brochure available on the SAMS portal.
5. As per previous year practice, the CAF fees and Admission fees will be taken through online mode for this academic session.
6. While applying for the CAF for B.Ed., B.H.Ed. & M.Ed. Courses applicants are advised to check the Eligibility Criteria mentioned in the Information Brochure.
7. The candidates, whose final U.G. results are awaited (not published), can also apply on-line in the CAF to appear the Entrance Examination. But they must provide their Choice Locking (preference of HEIs) and upload their marks by logging into the "Existing Students Login" as per the timeline fixed by the Higher Education Department.
8. The applicants wish to be considered for Scholarship from the Higher Education Department must upload the Residence, Income & Caste Certificates while filling up the CAF. Hence, they are advised to keep ready the required certificates in well advance before filling up the CAF. If the applicants fail to upload the certificates during filling up the CAF, another chance will be given to upload the certificates during updation of graduation marks/choice filling timeline.
9. The Timelines mentioned below are tentative and if all the seats are filled in a particular round, then subsequent rounds will not take place.

Timeline for 2 Year B.Ed., B.H.Ed., M.Ed. courses e-Admission for the year 2026-27 under 'Student Academic Management System (SAMS)' is given below. Any change in the timeline will be published on the website <https://te.samsodisha.gov.in/>. The applicants are requested to read the Information Brochure carefully.
